Competition Rules:

1. Eligibility: Open for all
2. Co-authorship of one is allowed.
3. Essays should be the original work of the participants and must not exceed 3,000 words (excluding footnotes). The language of the essays should be English. Any kind of plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
4. The submission should only in “doc. or docx.” format.
5. Submission should strictly follow the following rules:
Font - Time New Roman, Font size- 12, Line spacing- 1.5, Alignment-Justified
6. Bluebook 19th edition should be adhered to for the purpose of citations.
7. E-Certificates will be provided to all participants.



REGISTRATION
