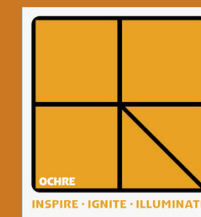

Introduction

Professional ethics refers to a set of rules that regulate the behaviour of those who practice law and those who work in the legal field. To the court and to the administration of justice, all members of the legal profession have primary responsibility.

Professional ethics may also be defined as the obligations that an advocate must fulfil while doing his or her profession. These are moral obligations and fundamental decency that everyone in this industry should be aware of. The code of ethics of this profession is considered to have been broken by an advocate who does not work with sincerity and does not follow the norms of behaviour.

The primary goal of legal ethics is to preserve the legal profession's respect and dignity and foster a spirit of amicable cooperation, honest and fair dealings between counsel and their clients, and safeguard the attorneys' societal obligations.
